FASE – 2 -

• Lo restante (\$ 3'000.000,00) lo cubrira la Agencia Nacional de Tránsito ANT .

El financiamiento de la construcción de la primera etapa está dentro del Programa de Rehabilitación del Eje Vial 1 Guayaquil – Piura, por un monto de USD \$. 4'800.000. El costo total aproximado es de USD \$. 8'000.000.
