## Personal Data Protection Notice for Representatives and Stakeholders of TALIS within Participating Countries/Territories

The OECD is committed to protecting the personal data it processes, in accordance with its Personal Data Protection Rules.

The Directorate for Education and Skills collects the personal data – including title, names, job title, employer, business address, email addresses and telephone numbers – belonging to contacts of TALIS within participating countries/territories. The data may be used to keep the OECD's internal contact database (Events Management System) up to date and to compile a public list of TALIS Governing Board (TGB) representatives and, if requested by the Participating Country/Territory, a public list of the local team involved in TALIS.

The personal data we collect will be stored at the OECD and accessible to OECD staff. For TGB representatives or the local team, the contact information will be made publicly available on the OECD website to facilitate networking among TGB representatives and the public. The personal data will be retained indefinitely for these purposes.

Under the <u>Rules</u>, you have rights to access and rectify your personal data, as well as to object to its processing, request erasure, and obtain data portability in certain circumstances.
