He also served as Senior Manager for PT Freeport Indonesia's (PTFI) Sustainable Development Department (1995-2001).

He started his international development career in 1972 as a US Peace Corps volunteer in the Philippines. Received a M.Sc. (1985) in Agriculture & Resources Economics, University of Hawaii (East-West Center), and a B.Sc. (1972) in Resources Development, Michigan State University.
