

Hansjörg Blöchliger

Head of Fiscal Federalism Network, Economics Department OECD

Hansjörg Blöchliger is the Head of the Network on Fiscal Relations Across Government Levels and Senior Economist at the Economics Department of the Organisation for Economic Co-Operation and Development (OECD).

Hansjörg is a Swiss national and joined the OECD in October 2005, where he leads a team of economists and statisticians, who focus on delivering economic analysis and advice on all issues relating to fiscal federalism as well as providing internationally comparable decentralisation statistics.

Prior to joining the OECD, Hansjörg was deputy director in a Swiss economic research and forecasting institute. Hansjörg led a team of around 15 economists that focused on identifying the structural factors which underpin national and regional growth. He was involved in an encompassing reform of Swiss fiscal federalism in the late 1990s and early 2000s.

Between 1994 and 1999 Hansjörg was Assistant Professor and Lecturer at the University of Basel, Switzerland. He holds a Master Degree of the University of Zürich and a PhD in economics of the University of Basel.
