

Jana Plamínková

Jana Plamínková (* June 27, 1959 in Prague) is a Czech politician, since 2014 Councillor for environment and technical infrastructure of the City of Prague, and Mayor of the District of Prague-Slivenec since November 2006.

She studied geology at Charles University in Prague. After graduation, she first worked at Charles University, from 1986 to 1987 stayed on internships in China. Later, she worked as an editor of Science and Technology magazine and for environmental magazines.

She also cooperated for several years with the League of Ecological Alternatives, while writing the book *ABC of Ecofriendly Housing*. She has published articles about nature, the environment, energy conservation, alternative sources of energy, but also about travelling.

During the municipal elections in 2014, she was elected as a member of STAN for "triple-coalition" (SZ, KDU-CSL and STAN) to the Prague City Assembly. On November 26, 2014 she was elected councillor of the City of Prague.

She is chairwoman of the STAN Regional Committee in the City of Prague and a member of the STAN National Committee.

She entered municipal politics in 1998 in the Prague-Slivenec district, where she has been serving her third term as the District Mayor.
