

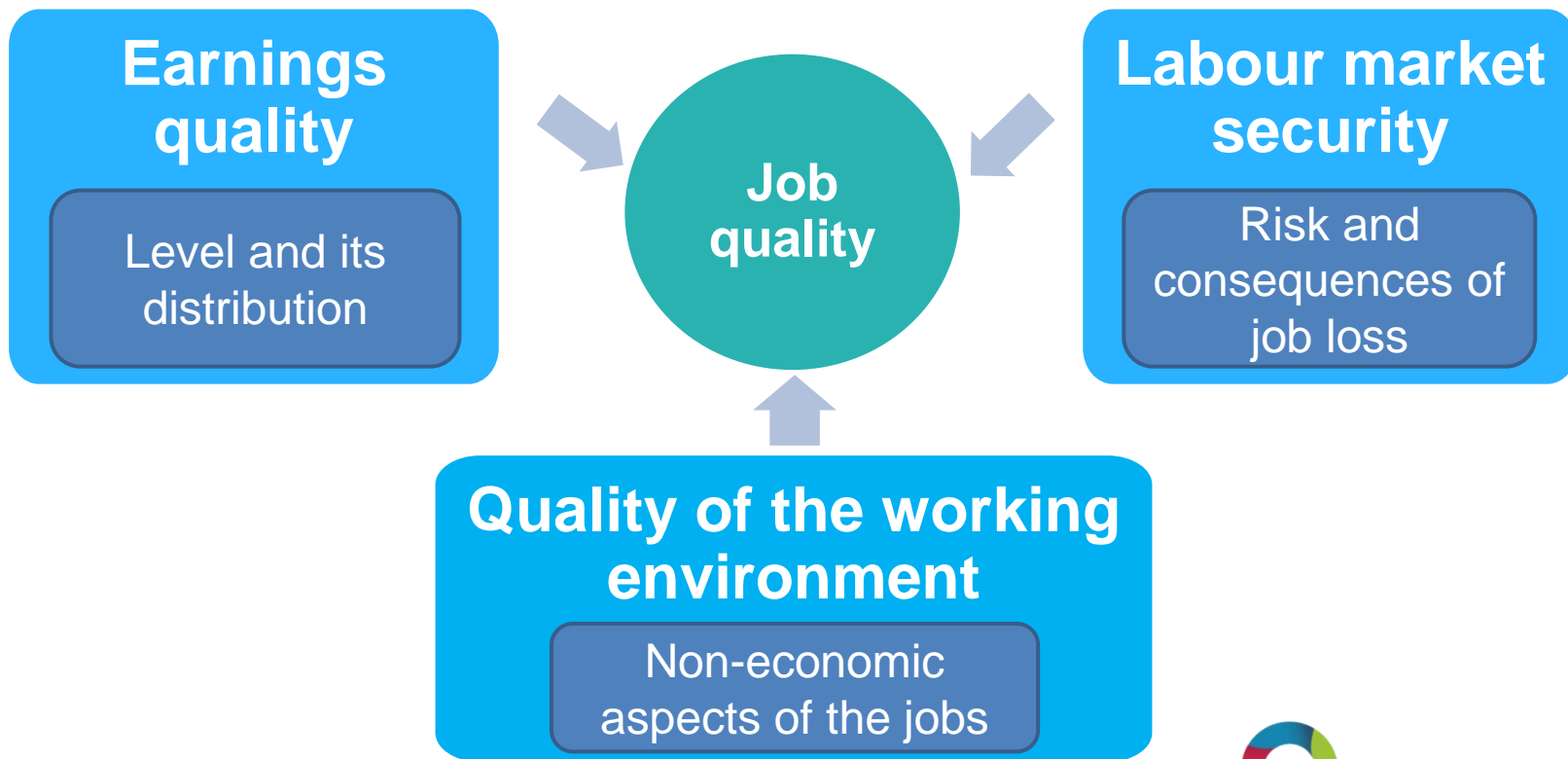

What is the role of job quality for health and productivity?



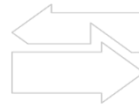
Job quality

High-performance work practices are linked to better job quality and higher productivity

As many as 2 in 5 employees may be in a strained job which risks impairing their health



Productivity



Health

Job strain is associated with higher sickness absence and lower performance at work



What can governments do?



Promote formal employment

Enhance the adequacy of labour regulations

Strengthen collective bargaining and social dialogue

Provide incentives for improving working conditions

Promote better and well-matched skills
