In this WCEF 2021 Accelerator session, a range of organisations will come together in two panels to discuss how to overcome the barriers to scaling up the global transition to a more resource efficient, circular economy. The first part will dive into the barriers faced by companies in transitioning to a circular economy and in scaling up circular business models. The second part will then look at the role of international actors in how to identify and implement solutions to these barriers and ensure trade and the circular economy become mutually supportive. In both parts of the session, an initial presentation sets the scene, after which a number of key stakeholders will debate what international barriers exist to the transition to a circular economy, and how international cooperation can provide solutions to overcome these barriers.
