Transportation

1. Crowne Plaza Corobici

The <u>Crowne Plaza Corobici</u> will serve as the venue for the meeting of the OECD/INFE Technical Committee on 23 May. It is located 16.6 km from the airport and 5.1 km from Conassif's Headquarters (INFE AB and LAC meetings and OECD-Conassif symposium venue on 22 and 24 May).

The <u>Hilton Sabana</u> is a no-smoking hotel, 14.8 km from the airport and 7.7 km from Conassif's Headquarters.



Getting there

Juan Santamaría International Airport (IATA:SJO) is located approx. 16 km from the Crowne Plaza Corobici.

Transfer by public transportation

There is a bus stop across from International Arrivals (approx. 100 metres away, behind the parking lot) on the route "Alajuela to San José" (must ask the driver) that have a stop right next to Crowne Plaza Corobici (45 minutes depending on traffic). The cost is approx. US \$1.5 payable in local currency directly to the driver.

Transfer via taxi

The charge from the airport to the city centre is usually around US \$50.00 and payable directly to the driver. The service can be arranged directly at the counters in International Arrivals (right after custom check).

Places of interest around San José

Costa Rica is a tourist destination with dozens of beaches, active volcanos, spring waters, national parks, and other places of interest within a few hours from its capital San José. For more information, please visit the website https://www.visitcostarica.com/en.

Practical information

Vaccination requirement

A **Yellow Fever vaccination** certificate <u>is required</u> on arrival from all travelers 9 months of age and older coming from a country with risk of Yellow Fever transmission. The vaccination requirement is imposed to protect against Yellow Fever since the principal mosquito vector Aedes aegypti is present in the territory. **Note**: Vaccination is required 10 days prior to your arrival date.

Covid-19

There are currently no COVID-19-related entry restrictions in Costa Rica. Covid-19 related certifications are no longer required to enter the country.

Insurance

You are strongly advised to have travel or medical insurance in case of any emergency that requires medical attention or other forms of assistance during this trip.

The organisers do not provide any medical insurance coverage for travelling to and participating in these events and therefore do not warrant or accept any responsibility relating to medical and injury claims.

If required, the hotel will assist with emergency medical attention at the venue of the event (first aid and paramedic attention). Should medical attention be required, there are two public medical facilities near the venue of the activity: Hospital San Juan de Dios and Hospital Mexico (both 10 minutes away).

Emergency number is 911.

Weather

As a tropical country, Costa Rica only has a dry season and a rainy season. May usually marks the beginning of the rainy season although we are currently under the dry effects of "El Niño". Temperatures in San José may vary from 16° to 27° Celsius (60.8° to 80.6° Fahrenheit). For more information, please consult the weather forecast issued by the National Institute of Meteorology.

Electricity

For Costa Rica there are two associated plug types:



Costa Rica operates on a 110V supply voltage.

Taxes

Costa Rica has a value-added tax (VAT) rate of 13%.

Time Zone

Costa Rica time zone is UTC/GMT - 6 hours.

Currency Exchange

The local currency is the Colon and is priced approximately at ¢507 for USD \$1.00. If you want to exchange currency, you can preferably do it at any bank located near the venue of the event.

Credit/Debit Cards

Credit cards are widely accepted throughout Costa Rica, especially Visa, Mastercard and American Express. Before making your purchase, find out with the staff of the shop if your specific credit card will be accepted. Some commercial establishments also accept payments in US Dollars.

Language

Costa Rica's language is Spanish.

Water

Tap water in Costa Rica is drinkable.

Restaurants and Tipping

Tipping is discretionary. Restaurants usually include a service charge, and these is always clearly stated on the menus. The usual tip amount is about a 10%, but the size of the tip should be according to the degree of your satisfaction with the services rendered.

Liquor and Smoking Laws

Alcohol can be purchased and consumed in restaurants, bars and supermarkets during their opening hours without restrictions.

Smoking is prohibited in all public places, including Conassif's premises.
