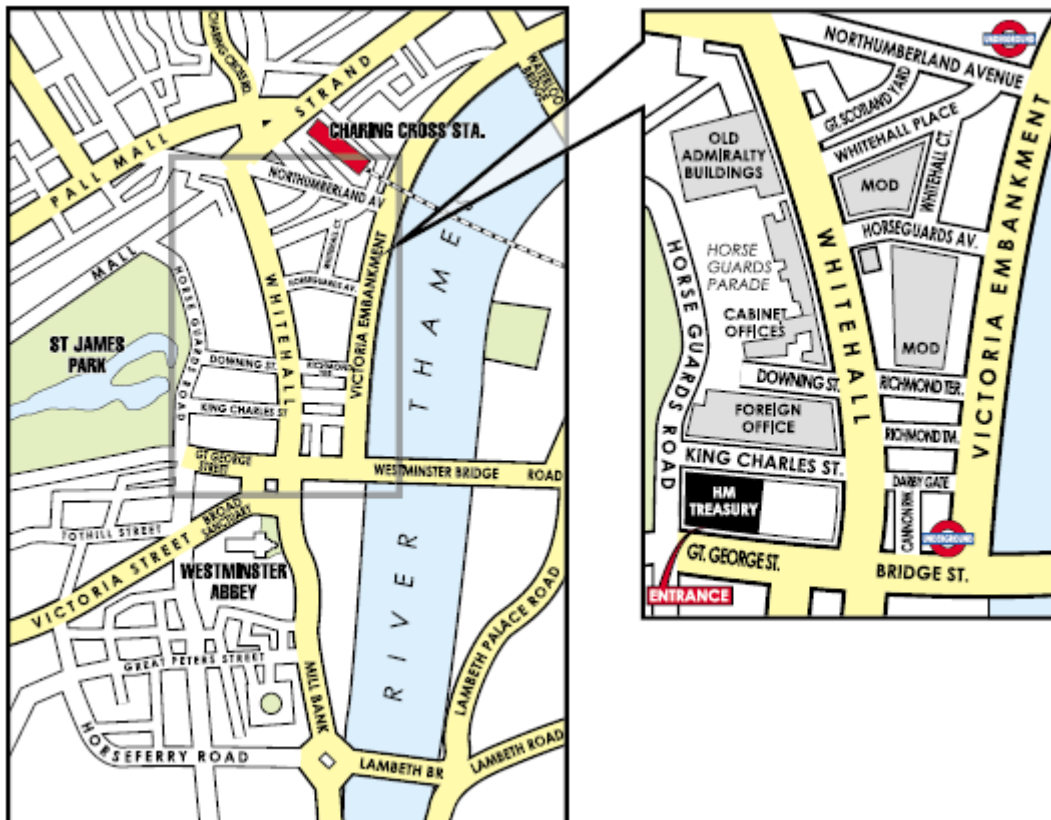

Travel

Public Transport

- It is no longer possible to pay cash fares on London buses. You can pay using an Oyster card or a contactless payment card to pay for single fares on buses (not trams) at the pay as you go fare of £1.50
- Single Underground cash fare from zone 1 to zone 2 - £4.70. With an Oyster card the fare is £2.40 from Zone 1 to Zone 2

- Top up Oyster cards are available from Underground stations and many shops around London. You can also purchase online at www.tfl.gov.uk . A deposit of £5 is required but the cost of travel on Buses and Tubes is reduced

- Heathrow - Heathrow Express to Paddington Station £19.00 single (departing every 15 mins – 05:07am to 11:53pm Monday to Saturday – 06:18am to 11:48pm Sunday)

London Underground, Piccadilly line, single ticket to central London (zone1) £5.30
- Gatwick – Gatwick Express to London Victoria £18.90 single (departing every 15 mins – 04:35am to 01:35am Monday to Sunday). www.gatwickexpress.com
National Rail services also available
- Stansted – Stansted Express to London Liverpool Street £22.50 single (departing every 15mins during peak hours - 05:30am to 01:30am Monday to Sunday – last train departs at 00:30am Monday to Friday). www.stanstedexpress.com
Trains call at Tottenham Hale approximately 11 minutes after the timetabled departure from London Liverpool Street
Please note that Tottenham Hale Underground Station (for the Victoria Line) does not open until 05:20am Monday to Saturday and 07:00am on Sunday. Passengers are advised to join the service at London Liverpool Street before this time
