Antonia Leroy leads projects on policies for innovation and fisheries crimes as a Policy Analyst in the OECD Natural Resources Policies Division. Prior to her current role she researched fisheries law and the implications of environmental policies on fisheries at the Institutut de Recherche en Développement (IRD) and the Agence Française de Développement (AFD).

Ms. Leroy has worked on fisheries policy issues from a cross-sectoral perspective on strengthening ocean governance frameworks in areas beyond national jurisdiction and on illegal, unreported and unregulated (IUU) fishing and related economic crimes.

In parallel, Ms. Leroy is PhD candidate at the University of Perpignan Via Domitia exploring issues related to international law of the sea and the challenges posed by IUU fishing. She also holds a Masters in European and International Studies from the University of Paris 8.
