She currently acts as Senior Expert to the FAO's programme on Circular Bioeconomy in Agri-food systems. Marta has been working for eight years at FAO's Bioeconomy unit, supporting policy-makers to develop national and regional bioeconomy strategies and developing knowledge products on sustainable and circular bioeconomy. She coordinates the 'International Sustainable Bioeconomy Working Group', a knowledge-exchange platform focused on sustainability of bioeconomy innovations, policies and practices.

The Working Group and the FAO programme were created after more than 60 Ministers of Agriculture at the Global Forum for Food and Agriculture in 2015, and again in 2021, called FAO to work on a sustainability framework for the bioeconomy. As of January 2022, FAO and its Members have incorporated Bioeconomy as a priority area in the Strategy 2022-2031.
