Dr. Lisa Emelia Svensson is the Director for Ocean, at the UN Environment, heading up the marine and costal ecosystem work program in the UN. Before taking up her assignment in UN, she was Sweden's Ambassador for the Ocean, where she advised the Government of Sweden on international issues on ocean affairs. Earlier appointments include Ambassador for Corporate Social Responsibility, Trade Negotiator in the European Commission, DG Trade, where she was the lead negotiator for the sustainable development chapters in the EU Free Trade Agreements. She has also been a Diplomat-in-Residence at the Johns Hopkins University, (SAIS), where she conducted research on climate change. She holds a PhD in political economy.
