Nolwenn is a Research Analyst at the Ellen MacArthur Foundation in the UK. Her work mainly focuses on increasing knowledge base on plastics and engaging policymakers and international institutions to the New Plastics Economy, a three-year initiative aiming to apply the principles of the circular economy to rethink and redesign the global plastics system. It brings together key stakeholders such as leading companies, cities, philanthropists, policymakers, academics, NGOs and citizens to catalyse change.

Prior to joining the Foundation, Nolwenn worked as a Project Officer for the French Environmental and Energy Management Agency (ADEME) for three years, in France and then in New Caledonia, focusing on circular economy and waste management, including in tropical coastal areas. She also worked in an environmental consultancy in Paris, and on biodiversity and water resources in the public sector in Chile.

She holds a MSc in Environmental Project Management, Public Policy and Economics from the Institute of Political Studies of Grenoble, France, in partnership with the National Polytechnic Institute.
