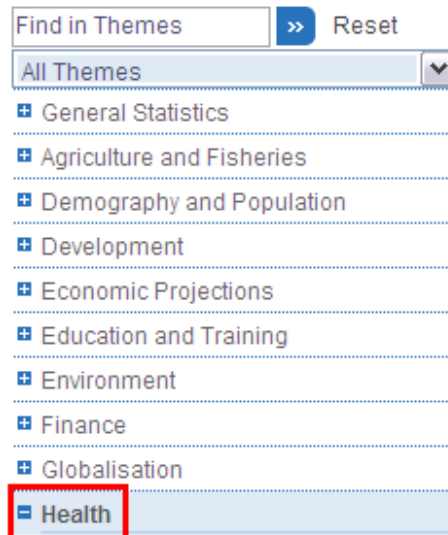




OECD Health Statistics 2023 How to create tables in OECD.Stat

1. To access the online Health database, go to **OECD.Stat** via <http://stats.oecd.org/Index.aspx>.
2. Go to the theme **Health** in the list displayed on the left and click to access all datasets. You can also access all data series in OECD.Stat via <https://oe.cd/ds/health-statistics>.



3. To **access the data tables from OECD Health Statistics 2022**, go into the datasets (for instance Non-Medical Determinants of Health, see example below), and click on a pre-defined query (for instance Body weight).

4. To **modify the parameters**, click on **Customise > Selection**, and then on **Variable**, **Unit**, **Country** or **Year**, and click on **View data** once done. You can also export your selection directly into Excel (Export > Excel).

5. To move the dimensions and change the table's layout, go to **Customise > Layout**, and click on the arrows to add/remove dimensions and to reorganise them, then click on **View Data** once done.
