Coherence between regional and domestic perspectives

- Trade policy Forums discussed
- WTO/RTAs/Integration Systems
- Domestic policy not always coherent within integration systems
- Coordination is key
- Different levels and different stakeholders

Main tensions between trade and environment



- Economies of the Americas depend at large on natural resources. Highlights relevance of SD approch
- Trade negotiation interactive process, in the región common but differentiated responsibility. Achieving positive results requires coherent strategies based on market opportunities, risk mitigation and equity
- No eco dumping: Environmental Rule of Law including compliance and enforcemeng are enabling conditions for trade, investment business climate

Possible Next Steps



Sustainable Development

- Reflecting the inter-dependent and mutually supportive linkages between the three dimensions of sustainable development – economic development, social development and environmental protection – of which trade is an integral component, they reinforce the objectives of sustainable development.
- Assessment/ exam of economic, social and environmental issues in Parties and in other countries likely to be affected.
- Consistency and policy coherence amongst WTO displines and topics such as: Market Access, Investment, Procurement, Ag,EGS, Trade and Climate Change)

Strengthening linkages



- Trade and Env. Agenda + : Integral approach with or without environmental provisions:
 - Winners vs. Loosers (Id. incentives vs. impacts)
 - Pro activity in streamlining or favoring market Access for EGS or environmentally friendly (Centralamerica vs. Andean FTAs)
 - Incentives beyond tariffs: value added in exports
 - Effects of subsidies in prodcution-consumption patterns, land use change and chemicals.
 - Asimetríes and Tensions (investment)
 - Back to basics: Biodiversity and TK (ie. PTPA)
 - Coherence among RTAs and MEAs (concepts matter)
- Environment=Competitiveness
- Market Access to developing countries requires environmental and social performance and compliance (EU: PIP, GAP, etc),
- Policy planning



- Better than other alternatives
- Satisfaction of environmental interest in acceptable and durable manner contributing to SD
- Best of multiple options
- Legitimacy further to standards
- Improvement –or at least not damagingrelationship
- Identification of specific, applicable and firm commitments
