

Data Protection Notice for the PISA for Development Out-of-School Assessment International Technical Workshop

The Programme of International Student Assessment (PISA) for Development Out-of-School Assessment International Technical Workshop is a webinar event taking place on 3 December 2020, where international stakeholders consisting of country representatives and other international organisations will summarise their experiences and key takeaways from the PISA for Development Out-of-School survey. The webinar is hosted by the OECD Directorate for Education and Skills.

The webinar will include panellists who will actively participate in the webinar event and present on certain topics. The webinar will be recorded using OECD's licensed Zoom account.

The webinar will involve the collection of personal data, including:

- identification data (e.g. name/username, video and audio, email address)
- opinions expressed during the webinar
