Sociologist and Master in Political Science, she is a retired professor at the State University of Campinas/Unicamp. She is member of the National Board of Education and President of ABAVE (National Association of Educational Evaluation).

She was Vice-Minister of Education of Brazil and Vice-Chair of the PISA Governing Board at OECD (2016-2018). She was also member of the Global Alliance for Literacy at the SDG-Education 2030 Steering Committee at UNESCO. Between 2003 and 2015, she served at the government of São Paulo as State Secretary of Education; member of the State Board of Education and State Secretary of Social Development. Between 1995 and 2002, she was President of the National Institute of Educational Studies and Research (INEP) and developed the National System of Assessment for Basic Education/SAEB and the National Exam of High School/ENEM. She is member of the Brazilian Education Academy and of the São Paulo Education Academy. She was awarded several national titles and medals and has published several articles, book's chapters and researches on Education Public Policies.
